

Student Emergency Needs Program



You may not know that 45% of LPS students qualify for free or reduced lunch. Students in these families often do not have access to transportation to school due to circumstances beyond their control. When a family / student is in a situation where they need transportation, bus passes are provided.

Emergency funds help students come to school ready to learn, and address needs that go beyond the walls of the classroom. Each year, hundreds of student emergency needs like rent, utilities, eyeglasses and prescriptions are met. These donor dollars address critical and urgent needs of families.

Spark Summer Learning

Learning shouldn't end when the school year does, which is why we launched Spark Summer Learning. Research shows that the summer months can be a time when our children experience summer learning loss (often called "summer slide"), falling behind in key areas like reading and math. By taking advantage of opportunities to explore new topics and engage with hands-on learning experiences during the summer, our students can reach their full academic potential while having a blast.


Trustee Events
